

RED WINES

200 Pasquier Desvignes Châteauneuf-du-Pape – €140

Côtes du Rhône, France

Grape: Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre, Cinsault, Muscardin, Vescapese, Picpoul Noir

Tasting Notes: A ruby red and mature-toned elegant wine. On the nose, cherry, blackberry, spice, leather, and light mineral notes are present. On the palate, it offers a sophisticated structure with a powerful body, balanced tannins, and layered spice notes. Aged for 18 months in French oak barrels, it finishes long and elegant.

201 Famille Perrin Côtes du Rhône Rouge Reserve – €75

Côtes du Rhône, France

Grape: Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah

Tasting Notes: A classic Rhône wine with deep ruby red color. On the nose, red fruits, cherry, light spices, and floral notes stand out. On the palate, it offers soft tannins, balanced acidity, and a refined layer of spice. Aged for 12 months in French oak, it provides a vibrant and balanced drinking experience.

202. Chateau Grand Champs – €52

Bordeaux, France

Grape: Merlot

Tasting Notes: A sophisticated wine with deep ruby red color, reflecting the classic Bordeaux character. On the nose: blackcurrant, ripe plum, tobacco, and light spice notes. The palate reveals well-structured tannins, balanced acidity, and oak nuances, offering a rounded profile. Aged for 12 months in French oak barrels, it ends with an elegant and balanced finish.

203. Medoc-Dulong Reserve – €80

Bordeaux, France

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes: A wine with deep burgundy color, showcasing the signature characteristics of the Médoc region. On the nose: blackcurrant, blackberry, tobacco, and subtle vanilla notes. The palate presents a full body with refined tannins, balanced acidity, and oak influence, bringing out layers of spice and cocoa. Aged 18 months in French oak with a long and elegant finish.

204. Levalet IGP Pays d'Oc – €50

Languedoc-Roussillon, France

Grape: Malbec

Tasting Notes: A dark purple, rich and fruity wine. The nose displays ripe blackberry, black plum, and light spice. The palate delivers a full-bodied profile with smooth, well-defined tannins and balanced acidity. Aged 6 months in used oak barrels, with medium-long finish showing cocoa and spice touches.

205. Gérard Bertrand – Le Viala 2009 – € 317

Minervois-La Livinière AOP, Languedoc, France

Grapes: Syrah, Grenache, Carignan

Tasting Notes: Deep ruby red color with light brick hues on the rim, indicating age. On the nose: black fruits (blackberry, black cherry), spices (black pepper, tobacco, cinnamon), and oak-driven notes of vanilla, cedar, and coffee. A full-bodied, robust wine with great structure.

206. Chateau Cantin Grand Cru Classe 2019 – €135

Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, France

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes: A strong yet elegant Bordeaux wine with deep ruby color. The nose reveals blackcurrant, ripe plum, tobacco, and cocoa. The palate offers a full body with silky tannins and balanced acidity. Aged 18 months in French oak barrels, delivering vanilla and spice notes with a long, refined finish.

207. Chateau De Lamarque Supérieur Classe 2017 – €135

Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot Tasting Notes: Deep burgundy in color, with classic Médoc elegance and strength. The nose shows blackcurrant, mulberry, tobacco, and hints of cocoa. On the palate, it presents firm yet refined tannins, balanced acidity, and integrated oak notes of vanilla and spice. Aged 18 months in French oak, with a long, layered finish and excellent aging potential.

208. Beaujolais Victor Bérard – €60

Bourgogne, France

Grape: Gamay

Tasting Notes: Light and elegant with vivid ruby red color. Aromas of strawberry and blackcurrant are dominant. The palate is soft and silky with vibrant summer fruit and a light spice edge. A refreshing and fruity wine, ideal with summer dishes, grilled meats, and vegetables.

212. Réserve De Saint Jacques – €130

Pomerol, Bordeaux, France Grape: Merlot

Tasting Notes: A deep ruby red wine reflecting the elegance of Pomerol. The nose shows ripe blackcurrant, plum, truffle, tobacco, and spice. The palate offers velvety tannins, balanced acidity, and oak-induced flavors of cocoa, vanilla, and spice. A refined wine with a long, rounded, and sophisticated finish. Aged 12 months in French oak.

213. Chateau La Fleur De Petrus 2017 – €1500

Pomerol, Bordeaux, France

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Franc

Tasting Notes: One of the most prestigious wines from Pomerol, with deep ruby color and exceptional elegance. Aromas of ripe blackcurrant, plum, violet, truffle, cocoa, and tobacco. The palate offers silk-like tannins, bright acidity, and perfect balance. Aged 18 months in French oak with layers of vanilla, spice, and light smokiness. Long, layered, and refined; a true collector's wine.

214. Chateau Petrus 1997 – €15,000

Pomerol, Bordeaux, France

Grape: Merlot

Tasting Notes: A refined and sophisticated Bordeaux with deep ruby red color. On the nose: black plum, currant, violet, tobacco, and spice. On the palate: silky tannins, perfectly balanced acidity, and rich fruit layers. Aged for 24 months in French oak, offering cocoa, vanilla, and subtle spice. A deep, complex wine with great aging potential.

215. Memoro Rosso – €40

Tuscany, Italy

Grapes: Primitivo, Montepulciano, Nero d'Avola, Merlot

Tasting Notes: A rich and balanced red with deep ruby color. Aromas of ripe red fruits, dried plum, spice, tobacco, and soft vanilla. The palate shows round tannins, full body, and balanced acidity. Aged in mixed oak (French & American), offering notes of cocoa, spice, and toasted hints. A warm and enjoyable finish.

216. Nipozzano Chianti Rùfina Riserva – €95

Tuscany, Italy

Grape: Sangiovese

Tasting Notes: A classic Chianti Riserva with bright ruby color and balanced structure. The nose features ripe cherry, pomegranate, spice, leather, and soft tobacco. The palate offers lively acidity, fine tannins, and a structured body. Aged 12 months in Slavonian oak with touches of vanilla, cocoa, and spice.

217. Tenuta di Biserno Insoglio del Cinghiale IGT – €240

Tuscany, Italy

Grapes: Syrah, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot

Tasting Notes: Deep ruby in color, rich and balanced. Aromas of black cherry, blackberry, spice, tobacco, and cocoa. On the palate: soft yet firm tannins, vibrant acidity, and layered fruit. Aged 12–16 months in French oak, with vanilla, black pepper, and toasted accents. Medium-long finish.

218. Mazzei Castello di Fonterutoli 'Siepi' – €500 Tuscany, Italy

Grapes: Merlot, Sangiovese

Tasting Notes: Powerful and refined, with deep ruby color. Aromas of ripe black cherry, blackberry, cocoa, tobacco, and sweet spice. On the palate, full-bodied with silky tannins and balanced acidity. Aged 18 months in French oak, showing vanilla, pepper, and toasted notes. Long and layered finish with great aging potential.

219. Villa Antinori I.G.T – €100

Tuscany, Italy

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese, Petit Verdot, Syrah

Tasting Notes: Elegant and balanced with bright ruby color. Nose reveals cherry, ripe plum, spice, tobacco, and soft vanilla. On the palate, soft tannins, vibrant acidity, and integrated oak. Aged 12 months in French and Slavonian oak, with cocoa, clove, and light toast. Refined and enjoyable.

220. Santero Dilé D Rosso – €110

Piedmont, Italy

Grape: Barbera

Tasting Notes: Fruity and fresh with bright ruby red color. Aromas of red fruits, strawberry, cherry, and spice. Palate shows soft tannins, balanced acidity, and a silky texture. With light sweetness and a medium finish, it's refreshing and fun. Aged in stainless steel.

221. Pellissero Barbaresco – €300 Piedmont, Italy

Grape: Nebbiolo

Tasting Notes: A refined and powerful Nebbiolo with deep ruby color. The nose shows rose, red fruits, cherry, cinnamon, and leather. The palate reveals a full body, prominent yet polished tannins, and balanced acidity. Oak aging brings out spice, vanilla, and earthy notes. A complex and prestigious wine with long, layered finish. 24 months in oak.

Bourgogne, France

Grape: Pinot Noir

Tasting Notes: Bright ruby red with elegance and balance. On the nose: red cherry, strawberry, raspberry, and subtle spices. The palate is soft with lively acidity and a silky mouthfeel. Hints of vanilla and spice come from gentle oak aging. Medium-long finish, fresh and refined.

210. Chateau Smith Haut Lafitte Grand Cru Classe 2017 – €700

Pessac-Léognan, Graves, Bordeaux, France

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot Tasting Notes: Deep ruby red, intense and sophisticated. Aromas of blackcurrant, ripe cherry, tobacco, graphite, and cocoa. On the palate, it's full-bodied with velvety tannins and perfectly balanced acidity. Aged for 24 months in French oak, showing vanilla, spice, and smoky hints. Long, complex, and age-worthy.

211. Chateau La Sirène De Giscours Grand Cru Classé 2017 – €250

Margaux, Bordeaux, France

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot Tasting Notes: A sophisticated Bordeaux wine with deep ruby color and the refined style of Margaux. Aromas of blackcurrant, ripe plum, violet, tobacco, and spice dominate the nose. On the palate, silky tannins, balanced acidity, and well-integrated oak notes lead to a complex structure. Aged 18 months in French oak with layers of vanilla, cocoa, and spice.

222. Dezzani DOC Rosso "Otto Bucce" – €45

Piedmont, Italy

Grapes: Dolcetto, Barbera, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Bonarda, Albarossa, Freisa, Syrah

Tasting Notes: A rich and characterful wine with deep ruby color. On the nose: ripe red fruits, cherry, blackberry, spice, and light floral notes. The palate is balanced with rounded tannins and vibrant acidity. French oak aging adds vanilla, cocoa, and mild spice touches. Medium-long, elegant finish. 18 months in oak.

223. Casalforte Merlot IGT – €50

Veneto, Italy

Grape: Merlot

Tasting Notes: A soft and fruity red with deep ruby hue. The nose opens with ripe red plum, blackberry, sweet spice, and soft vanilla. The palate shows velvety tannins, structured body, and balanced acidity. Oak aging adds cocoa, caramel, and spice layers. Medium-long finish. 6 months in oak.

224. Casalforte Valpolicella Superiore – €57

Veneto, Italy

Grapes: Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella

Tasting Notes: A rich and balanced red with dark ruby color. On the nose: ripe red fruits, sour cherry, blackberry, spice, and subtle tobacco. The palate presents silky tannins, vibrant acidity, and a well-built body. Slavonian oak aging contributes notes of cocoa, vanilla, and spice. Medium-long, complex finish. 12 months in oak.

225. Masi Costasera Amarone Classico – €245

Verona, Italy

Grapes: Corvina Veronese, Rondinella, Molinara

Tasting Notes: A powerful Amarone with deep ruby color and intense character. Aromas of dried plum, cherry liqueur, cocoa, and sweet spice dominate. The palate is full-bodied, velvety, and complex. Made using the Appassimento method. Long and elegant finish. 24 months in oak.

226. Vecchio Marone Primitivo Di Puglia – €50

Puglia, Italy

Grape: Primitivo

Tasting Notes: A bold and fruit-forward wine with deep ruby color. The nose reveals ripe blackberry, plum, vanilla, and sweet spice. Full-bodied with soft tannins and balanced acidity. Oak aging adds cocoa and toasted notes. Long, warm finish. 12 months in French and American oak.

227. 770 Miles Zinfandel – €52

California, USA

Grape: Zinfandel

Tasting Notes: A soft, fruit-driven wine with ruby red color. Aromas of ripe blackberry, raspberry, sweet spice, and vanilla. The palate is full-bodied with soft tannins and balanced acidity. American oak aging brings out vanilla and cocoa notes. Medium-long, warm finish. 9 months in oak.

228. Opus One – €3000

Napa Valley, California, USA

Grape: Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes: A sophisticated Napa Valley wine with aromas of blackcurrant, blackberry, tobacco, and cocoa. Silky tannins, full body, and a long, elegant finish. A prestigious wine with excellent aging potential. Aged 18–24 months in new French oak.

229. Catena Malbec - €70

Mendoza, Argentina

Grape: Malbec

Tasting Notes: Deep purple color and rich aromatic profile. Nose shows ripe blackberry, plum, violet, and cocoa. The palate is full-bodied with silky tannins and balanced acidity. French oak aging provides vanilla and spice notes. Long and refined finish. 12–18 months in oak.

230. Matsu El Recio – €104

Toro, Spain

Grape: Tinto Toro (Tempranillo)

Tasting Notes: A powerful and refined Tempranillo with deep ruby color. Aromas of blackberry, dried fig, cocoa, tobacco, and spice. Full-bodied with silky tannins and balanced acidity. Oak aging reveals vanilla and light toast. Long and elegant finish. 14 months in oak.

231. Muriel Rioja Crianza Fincas De La Villa – €55

Rioja, Spain

Grape: Tempranillo

Tasting Notes: A classic, balanced Rioja with elegance. Red fruits, vanilla, tobacco, and mild spice on the nose. Medium-bodied with soft tannins and balanced structure. American oak aging adds vanilla and toast. Pleasant, medium-long finish. 12 months in oak.

232. Pago De Carraovejas 2019 – €200

Ribera del Duero, Spain

Grape: Tinto Fino

Tasting Notes: Deep ruby red, rich and sophisticated. Aromas of blackberry, black plum, cocoa, tobacco, and spice. On the palate: full-bodied, silky tannins, excellent acidity. Oak aging adds vanilla and light smoke. Long and elegant finish. 12–18 months in new oak.

233. Errazuriz Estate Cabernet Sauvignon – €60 Chile

Grape: Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes: Deep ruby color with intensity and balance. Nose reveals blackcurrant, plum, rosemary, and spice. On the palate: full body, defined tannins, and bright acidity. Oak aging brings out vanilla and cocoa. Long and balanced finish. 12 months in French & American oak.

236. Chamlija Nevi Şahsına Münhasır – €80 Kırklareli, Turkey

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc

Tasting Notes: Deep purple tones and a bold, character-driven style. On the nose: ripe black fruits, cherry, spice, tobacco, and subtle mineral notes. The palate delivers a full body, firm tannins, and lively acidity. Oak aging imparts vanilla, cocoa, and a touch of smokiness. Long, sophisticated finish. 16 months in French oak.

237. Chateau Kalpak – €80

Tekirdağ, Turkey

Grapes: Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot

Tasting Notes: A powerful and elegant Bordeaux-style blend with deep ruby color. Aromas of blackcurrant, ripe plum, tobacco, spice, and hints of leather. On the palate: full body, silky tannins, and balanced acidity. Aged 18–24 months in French oak, showing vanilla, cocoa, and light smoke on the finish. High aging potential.

238. Arcadia Odrysia Red Blend – €55

Lüleburgaz, Turkey

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot

Tasting Notes: A balanced, fruity wine with bright ruby color. Red forest fruits, cherry, spice, and floral notes on the nose. Medium-bodied with soft tannins and vibrant acidity. Oak aging adds hints of vanilla and cocoa. Medium-long, fresh and refined finish. 12–18 months in oak.

239. Prestige Kalecik Karası – €70

Ankara, Turkey

Grape: Kalecik Karası

Tasting Notes: Elegant and balanced with bright ruby color. Aromas of ripe strawberry, cherry, pomegranate, rose, and soft spice. On the palate: medium body, soft tannins, and lively acidity. Oak aging gives vanilla and cocoa hints. Medium-long finish, fresh and refined. 9 months in oak.

240. Vinkara Winehouse Dömi-Sec – €50

Ankara, Turkey

Grape: Kalecik Karası

Tasting Notes: A semi-dry, fruity wine with light ruby red color. Nose shows ripe red fruits, cherry, strawberry, and spice. On the palate: medium body, soft tannins, and slightly sweet character. Refreshing, round, and enjoyable with lively acidity. Aged in stainless steel.

241. Kavaklıdere Selection – 62€

Elazığ, Türkiye

Grape: Öküzgözü, Boğazkere

Tasting Notes: It is a rich and balanced wine with a dark ruby red color. Black cherry, blackberry, tobacco and spice notes are evident on the nose. It offers a medium-full body, silky tannins and balanced acidity on the palate. Thanks to the oak barrel maturation, vanilla and cocoa touches are felt. It provides a complex and elegant drinking experience with its long and refined finish. 12 Months oak.

242. Urla Nero d'Avola – 80 €

Izmir, Turkey

Grape variety: Nero d'Avola, Urla Karası

Tasting notes: A powerful and balanced wine with a dark ruby color. The aroma is ripe cherry, blackberry, spices and light tobacco. The taste is full-bodied, soft tannins and bright acidity. Thanks to oak aging, vanilla and cocoa are felt. A long and refined aftertaste makes this wine refined and pleasant. 12 months of aging.

243. Pendore Öküzgözü – 80 €

Manisa, Turkey

Grape variety: Öküzgözü

Tasting notes: A bright and balanced wine with a bright ruby hue. The aroma is wild berries, cherry, pomegranate and light spices. On the palate – medium body, soft tannins and high acidity. Light notes of vanilla and cocoa are felt thanks to oak aging. Medium-long, fresh and elegant finish. 6-9 months of aging.

244. Urla Nexus – €70

Izmir, Turkey

Grape variety: Merlot, Nero d'Avola, Cabernet Franc

Tasting notes: A powerful and sophisticated wine with a rich ruby color. The aromas include ripe black berries, cherries, tobacco, spices and light mineral notes. On the palate – full body, silky tannins and balanced acidity. Vanilla, cocoa and spices are felt thanks to French oak aging. Long, sophisticated finish. High aging potential. 18 months.

245. Sagavin – €80

Denizli, Turkey

Grape variety: Shiraz

Tasting notes: A rich and balanced wine with a deep ruby color. The aroma is ripe red berries, cherries, blackberries and light spices. On the palate, it has a medium to full body, soft tannins and bright acidity. Thanks to oak aging, vanilla and cocoa are felt. Long and refined finish. 12 months of aging.

234. Miriani Kindzmarauli Semi Sweet – €45

Kakheti, Georgia

Grape: Saperavi

Tasting Notes: A soft and balanced semi-sweet red with deep ruby color. Aromas of ripe blackberry, cherry, plum, and mild spice. Palate shows silky tannins, natural sweetness, and bright acidity. Fresh, fruity, and long finish. Aged in stainless steel.

235. Porta Caeli Ament Blend – €90

Marmara, Turkey

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Merlot

Tasting Notes: Deep ruby color, rich and refined blend. Ripe black fruits, cherry, tobacco, and spice dominate the nose. Full-bodied with silky tannins and balanced acidity. French oak aging brings vanilla, cocoa, and light smokiness. Long, elegant finish with aging potential. 18 months in French oak 236.

246. Kayra Allure Kalecik Karası – €50 Denizli, Turkey

Grape variety: Kalecik Karası

Tasting notes: Light and elegant wine with a bright ruby color. On the nose, strawberry, cherry, pomegranate and light floral notes. On the palate, soft tannins, balanced acidity and silky structure. Refreshing, fruity, with a medium-long and refined aftertaste. Aged 6 months

247. Prodom – €67

Aydin, Turkey

Grape variety: Okuzgozu, Kalecik Karası

Tasting notes: A powerful and balanced wine with a rich ruby color. On the nose, there are black berries, cherries, blackberries, tobacco and spices. On the palate, it has a full body, velvety tannins and bright acidity. Oak aging brings vanilla, cocoa and light smoky notes. Long and refined finish. 9 months of aging.

248. Paşaeli 6 N – €45

Kaz Mountains, Turkey

Grape variety: Karasakız

Tasting notes: A bright and balanced wine with a brilliant ruby hue. The aromas include red berries, cherry, pomegranate, spices and light earthy notes. The palate has a medium body, soft tannins and high acidity. Fruity, refreshing style. Medium-long, refined and pleasant finish. (Stainless steel).

Grape: Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes: It is a balanced and elegant wine with a dark ruby red color. Ripe red fruits, sour cherry, blackberry and light spice notes are evident on the nose. It offers a medium-bodied, soft tannin and lively acidity on the palate. Light vanilla and cocoa notes are felt with oak barrel touches. It provides a sophisticated and enjoyable drinking experience with its long and refined finish. 18 Months oak

On the palate, it offers a full body, silky tannins and balanced acidity. Thanks to the oak barrel maturation, vanilla, cocoa and light smoky touches are felt. It provides a sophisticated, complex and refined drinking experience with its long and elegant finish. (Stainless steel).

252. Alice Lermenos – 25€

Denizli, Türkiye

Grape variety : Öküzgözü Boğazkere Cabernet.Sauvignon

Tasting Notes: Light ruby in color. Red fruity aromas are evident on the nose, and fruity on the palate. A medium-bodied red with soft tannins, lively and crisp acidity. Balanced and easy to drink. Should be served within 1-2 years at 16 degrees, and should be tried with meat-minced meat pastries, meatballs and burgers Light ruby in color. Red fruity aromas are evident on the nose, and fruity on the palate. A medium-bodied red with soft tannins, lively and crisp acidity. Balanced and easy to drink.

253. Lucian Arkas Bağları İdol – 25€

İzmir , Türkiye

Grape variety : Kalecik karası Öküzgözü Cabarnet Sauv Merlot

Tasting Notes: A red wine produced from a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot grown organically at Lucian Arkas winery in Izmir. Rich blackberry and cherry aromas with velvety smooth tannins. Goes well with cheese and charcuterie plates, risotto, pasta and grilled meats. Produced using organic production methods that bring out the flavors of the Aegean Sea.

254. Nif Bagları Luz Eos – 25€

İzmir, Türkiye

Tasting Notes: Grape variety : Shiraz ve Sangiovese Nif Vineyards takes its name from one of Kemalpaşa's old names, Nymphaion, meaning forest-water fairy. The name of the wine, Luz, means "light" and the illustration of the Goddess of Dawn "Eos" on the front label was drawn by artist Umut Karaman.

255. Yanık Ülke – 25€

Manisa Türkiye

Grape variety : Merlot

Tasting Notes: Claret red in color. Has jammy red fruit-like bouquets. Medium-bodied, soft, light and easy to drink. Should be tried with poultry and red meats such as lamb and veal within 1-2 years.



300. Chateau Haut-Mouleyre Blanc – 65€

Bordeaux, France

Grapes: Sauvignon Blanc, Sémillon

Tasting Notes: A refreshing and balanced white wine with a bright pale yellow color. On the nose, green apple, pear, lemon peel, and light floral notes are noticeable. On the palate, it offers vibrant acidity, medium body, and a refreshing structure with mineral touches. It delivers a long and elegant finish with a fresh and balanced tasting experience. (Stainless steel.)

301. Calvet Réserve du Ciron Sauternes – Sweet – 100€

Bordeaux, France

Grapes: Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc, Muscadelle

Tasting Notes: A rich and sophisticated sweet wine with a golden yellow color. On the nose, honey, apricot, dried fig, tropical fruits, and light nutty notes stand out. Grapes: Touriga Nacional, Touriga Francesa, Tinta Roriz
